1. **DELIVERY** – Items for sale should be delivered to the sale site the day before the sale by prior arrangement with the auctioneers. All PTO shafts and pins should be secured to the relevant implement prior to sale.
2. **TRANSPORT** – Vendors are responsible for the transport of items to the sale site.
3. **CONDITIONS OF SALE** – The sale will be conducted subject to the Auctioneers usual Conditions of Sale (as amended) which will be displayed on the sale day and in the catalogue.
4. **RESERVES** – If a reserve is required on items it should be clearly stated on this form. Otherwise all items will be sold to the highest bidder. Any amendments to reserves should be submitted in writing to the Auctioneers before the sale day.
5. **UNSOLD LOTS** – Vendors must check the sold/unsold status of their lots with the Sale Office on the sale day. The Auctioneers accept no responsibility for any lots unsold and reserve the right to charge for the removal of items left on the sale site after the day of sale.
